RULES & REGULATIONS—FAILURE TO FOLLOW RULES RESULTS IN DISMISSAL FROM SHOW AND FAIRGROUNDS.

1. Exhibitors must provide all their own equipment, food and bedding during the show.
2. **ANIMALS SHOWING SIGNS OF SICKNESS SHOULD NOT ENTER FAIR GROUNDS. ANIMALS SHOWING SIGNS OF SICKNESS THAT SHOW UP WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE. IF SICK ANIMALS ARE TRAVELING WITH OTHER SHOW ANIMALS ALL ANIMALS WILL BE DISMISSED FROM THE SHOW.**
3. All animals will enter fairgrounds through approved entrance. Cars, trucks, trailers will not be able to park near large shelter. Unloading and loading animals will be done and vehicles will need to park in approved area.
4. All exhibitors and owners must follow fairground rules: No animals are allowed to walk throughout fairground area where food and rides are located.
5. **Entry fee for sheep and goats is \$15 for the FIRST animal— \$10 per additional animal registered before Aug. 19; \$25 per animal registered Aug. 20-Sept. 1; \$40 per animal registered after Sept. 1.**
6. Entries will be accepted up until the class starts. — Additional registration costs will be required.
7. The show judge and/or committee reserves the right to combine two or more classes as a group class when there is only 1 entry in a class.
8. Classes will be judged through sixth place.
10. Registration will begin at 3 p.m. Exhibitors must park as directed by fair officials. All spectators will be charged regular fair admission at the main fair gate. PARTICIPANTS WILL SHOW REGISTRATION FORM TO PARKING AND GATE ATTENDANT FOR ADMISSION.
